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IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION

Dear Parent/Guardian,

To comply with Oregon law, all new students must provide "evidence of immunization", with a minimum of one dose each of polio, mumps, rubella and diphtheria/tetanus, varicella, hepatitis B series and second dose of measles containing vaccines; or, an exemption(s) on a Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) form (attached).

REGISTRATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL THE CIS FORM IS COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO THE SCHOOL

A student transferring from out of state or another school within Oregon is required to provide proof of immunization within 30 days of registration. It is the parent or guardian's responsibility to see that the CIS form is completed and returned to the school.

Please complete and sign the form below. CIS form will be sent to you upon the school's receipt of your registration.

Registration is not complete unless the CIS form below is on file at the school.

I will have _____ (child's name) immunization record sent to this school/facility within 30 days of their initial enrollment. I understand that if, upon receipt, the record is not on a Certificate of Immunization Status form, or another state approved form, I am responsible to transfer this information onto the approved form. This form includes one of, or is a combination of, the following statements: (1) month and year* of each dose of each vaccine received, signed by the parent** or health care practitioner; (2) a religious exemption signed by the parent; or (3) a medical exemption, including the approved medical basis for exemption signed by a physician or representative of the local health department.

* Only the year of each vaccine is required if the records were on file in an Oregon School prior to December 1, 1981, and the child has remained continuously enrolled in an Oregon school, except where the month is needed to determine an age-specific requirement.

** Parent includes guardian of a child, or any adult responsible for the child.
