Dear Parents,

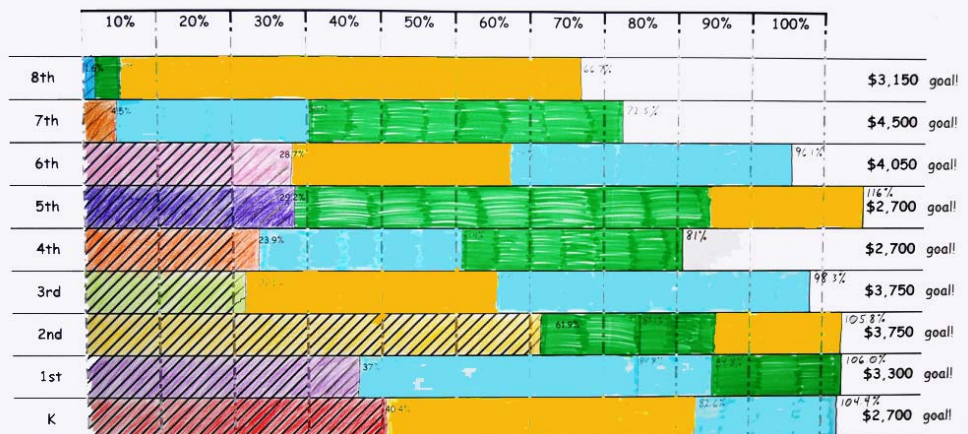

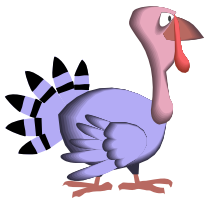
