Dear Parents,

With the days getting shorter it's time for reminders about student safety and the possibility of inclement weather. Please review this information and do your part to keep our children safe:

- The speed limit in the parking lot is 5 mph. Please exercise extreme caution when driving on the playground, especially during this dark and wet time of year.
- Teacher supervision is available before school starting at 8:10am, and after school until about 3:25pm. Students should not be dropped off in the morning any earlier than 8:10am.
- Inclement weather: In the event of inclement weather, St. Ignatius follows the decisions of Portland Public Schools regarding late opening or school closure. Listen to the TV or radio news for information, or check online news sources. We will make every effort to update the school website and/or voice mail system, but this is not always possible. If school must be dismissed during the school day, we will post this information on the school website and send it out to the local media. Please come and pick up your children immediately.
- We encourage parents to make their own decisions regarding keeping your family safe in treacherous weather. If at any time you feel it is not safe to be on the roads, we encourage you to stay at home or come to pick up your children. If the weather is dangerous, the best place for our children to be is at home with their families.
- On days when we are in school, you should send a coat or jacket with your child every day. We go outside to play whenever there is a break in the rain, even if it is cold.
- Please be especially careful when picking up children from extended care and after school activities that dismiss after dark.

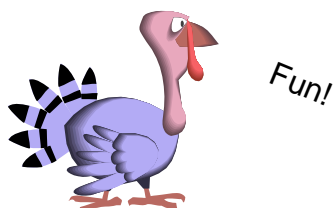

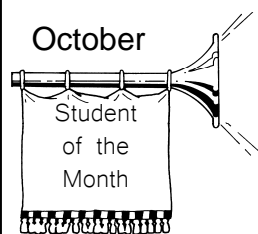
## PIZZICATO FUNDRAISER UPDATE
